



The above Plans is of a parcel of land granted to the Town of Adams by the Legislature of the State of New Hampshire in 1806 for the support of schools and the Gospel situated in said Adams and bounded as follows. viz Lot 1- is bounded on the south by a lot of land granted to the Town of Bartlett by the State of New Hampshire for the support of schools and the Gospel in 1806 - bounded east by the East Branch of Ellis river north by lot 402 - and west by double head mountain. Lots 402 and 3 are bounded south by lot 404 and east by the Eastern branch of Ellis River north by ungranted land and west by sd Double head mountain. Lot 404 is bounded on the west by Black Mountain on the east by land granted to Jonathan Gray - lot 405 - is bounded west by Gilmans Location north and south by ungranted land - lot corners and distances see your Plans. Lot 408 - is bounded west by land granted Anthony Vincent in 1806 East by land granted to the Town of Bartlett in 1806 north by Black Mt. south by the Great Brook.
